You will learn the history of felting in general, and specifically needle felting, along with useful techniques to allow you to add detail to your bird project and future projects. The Instructor: Judy Chapman has been creating craft projects since she was 11 years old. Her passion to learn and master ranged from sewing, embroidery, crocheting, cross stitch, and creating articulating bears from mohair.
