Description: Students will use seven basic colors and learn how to mix and make any color desired. We'll use fiber reactive dyes and watercolor paper.

The Instructor: Robin Pascal has been knitting for over 50 years, and teaching for 20 years. She teaches handpainting yarn and color mixing. She has an honors BFA from the University of Houston. She is a fiber artist: knitter, weaver, spinner, dyer and maker of one-of-a-kind dichroic glass buttons. She has judged knitting and weaving at the New Mexico State Fair, spinning at Taos Wool Festival and Fiber Arts Fiesta. She has won many awards for her knitting, weaving and spinning, including a Medallion at the Taos Wool Festival.
