Description: Handpaint a skein of yarn or warp with fiber reactive dyes and microwave. Anyone who wants to add multi-colored yarn to a project would enjoy this class.

The Instructor: Robin Pascal has been knitting for over 50 years, and teaching for 20 years. She teaches handpainting yarn and color mixing. She has an honors BFA from the University of Houston. She is a fiber artist: knitter, weaver, spinner, dyer and maker of one-of-a-kind dichroic glass buttons. She has judged knitting and weaving at the New Mexico State Fair, spinning at Fiber Arts Fiesta. She has won many awards for her knitting, weaving and spinning, including a Medallion at the Taos Wool Festival.

Level: Any skill level accepted. Teens over 12.

Class size: Maximum students 6

Students need to bring: 4 oz skein of yarn (tied with 4 S ties) or 4 oz warp, gloves, grubby clothes, plastic bag. Any fiber except poly, acrylic, or viscose. Instructor will provide: Dyes and microwave oven.
