Cotton Fabrics - 6 pieces of 6" square white and 6 pieces of 6" square white printed; two pieces of 3"x22" white printed; and 3 pieces 13"x 13" white. CLOTHES HANGER WITH CLIPS (HOLDS FABRIC IN THE AIR WHILE SPRAYING)

Instructor will provide: A required kit that includes: An assortment of fabric blocks and lace, (2) sizes of Fantastix tips, water brush pen, squeegee, large and small daubers, ink droppers, tidy tray, (1) API ink, (1) TSC DESIGN stencil, and (1) fabrico marker.
